Note

There are 722 sound files of which 721 have been transcribed. The one file not transcribed was deemed long and rambling and not worth the effort.

Transcriptions-filename-with-edition-date

All transcriptions have an "edition" date. This is the date of revision of the transcription. Over time, this will change as files are proofread additional times. All transcriptions being deposited at this time have an edition date of _ed-2016-02-27. These are the last 14 characters of all .trs files (not including the file extension). For example:

Tzina Botan AND308-JVC313 Cuscutaceae-sakapal 2013-07-19-a ed-2016-02-27.trs

Transcriptions-filename-with-no-edition-date

The exact same transcriptions are copied here but with a slight change in the filename: the edition date as been deleted. In this case the filename matches exactly the filename of the recording (with the extension changed from .trs to .wav). The following is the same abovementioned transcription with edition date removed. It is followed by the sound filename

This is a file of the data, including birthdates, of all project participants. It may be archived along with other material or put online but if the later perhaps it would be best to change birthdate to simply 'year of birth' as actual birth dates should not be placed online by third parties

Metadata and related files

This folder contains a document on filenaming codification (i.e., the semantics of the filenames used in this project) and a Synopsis of metadata fields for recordings (Amith), which explains the logic behind the metadata fields and the type of content expected for each.

There are five metadata files. Each genre/semantic field of transcriptions has been directly exported:

Botanica (577 records)

Comida (20 records)

Material-culture (46 records)

Medicine (79 records)

Finally, all records were combined into an All metadata file with 722 records. This is probably the metadata file that will be used for accessioning.
